AIMS AND SCOPE

Journal of Enterocolitis (J Enterocolitis) is a scientific open access, online-only periodical published in accordance with independent, unbiased, and double-blinded peer-review principles. The journal is published triannually in April, August, and December. The publication language of the journal is English.

Journal of Enterocolitis aims to contribute to the literature by publishing manuscripts at the highest scientific level on inflammatory bowel diseases. The journal publishes original articles, review articles, case reports, and letters to the editor that are prepared in accordance with ethical guidelines. The scope of the journal includes but is not limited to celiac, infectious enterocolitis, ischemic enterocolitis, microscopic colitis, mucous colitis, microbiota, nutrition and probiotics, eosinophilic enteritis, ulcerative colitis, Crohn's disease, lymphoma, and diarrhea.

The target audience of the journal includes specialists, researchers and professionals who are working and interested in the field of inflammatory bowel diseases.

Journal of Enterocolitis is currently indexed in Tubitak Ulakbim Medicine, EBSCO, GALE Cengage, Scilit, OUCI (Open Ukrainian Citation Index), and ASCI (Asian Science Citation Index).
